Week 1 - June 20-26

Required MDC Class – Tuesday mornings, 10:00 am -12:30 pm, \$100 for only those who auditioned and were accepted into MDC 2021-22. Classes are on June 22, 29, and July 6, 13, 20.

Required MDC Mini Class – Tuesday afternoons, 1:00 - 2:00 pm, \$80 for only those who auditioned and were accepted into MDC 2021-22. Classes are on June 22, 29, and July 6, 13, 20.

Tumbling For Contemporary Intensive - Tuesday-Friday 6/22-25, 2:00-3:30 pm, \$90 Taught by Miss Mantha. Tumbling technique meets contemporary style in this four day Intensive. 30 minutes of conditioning and an hour of strength moves with strong tumbling influence that will blend with contemporary choreography. On the last day, we will review and learn a combination that incorporates all new skills. (Must have at least one year of Contemporary, be able to do a good back bend and a good cartwheel. Pulling up from a backbend and being able to do a handstand will be helpful, but isn't required) 1 Point

Back Handspring Intensive – Saturday 6/26, 10:00-11:30 am, \$40, Taught by Coach David. Is your tumbler working on their Back Handspring, but hasn't quite gotten there yet? This is the Intensive for them! ½ Point

Back Tucks and Beyond Intensive - Saturday 6/26, 12:30-2:00 pm, \$40, Taught by Coach David. Does your tumbler have their back handspring? Let's get working on those back tucks! Do they already have their Back Tuck? Let's go beyond and work on roundoff back tuck, layouts, front tucks, or even add a half or full twist! ½ Point

Week 2 - June 27-30 & July 1-3

Princess Camp - Tuesday through Friday, 6/29 & 30, 7/1 & 2 - 10:30-11:30 am, taught by Miss Mantha. 4-7 year olds, \$80 to include crafts. Each day will be a different storybook princess and will include reading the story, a dance, games and a craft. ½ Point

Week 3 – July 4-10

Improve your Improv Intensive - Thursday 7/8, 10:00 am -12:00 pm, \$40 Taught by Miss Mantha. Improv is an incredibly important aspect of becoming a well-rounded dancer. In this intensive, we will explore how to make your own improv more compelling and how to connect with the music. Dancers will learn tips and prompts, improve confidence and play Improv games. (Must have one year of contemporary, one year of Jazz and a willingness to step out of your comfort zone) ½ Point

Week 4 - July 11-17

Stretch, Strengthen, Turns & Leaps Intensive – Mon. through Fri 7/12-16, 1:30-3:30 pm, Taught by Miss Mantha & Miss Lida. \$150 and offered to all those who have had at least one year of Level 3 through Level 5 dance. Work will be done on making your dancer more flexible, stronger, and better at leaps and turns. 1 Point (MDC +1 credit against demerits)

Acting for Dance – Thursday 7/15, 10:00 am -12:00 pm, \$40 Taught by Miss Mantha. Improve your facials for Contemporary, Broadway and Sassy Jazz! Learn how to use your face and body to convey emotions. (Must have at least one year of Contemporary and Jazz). ½ Point

Limbering Skills Workshop – Tuesday, Thursday & Friday, 7/13, 15. &16, 6:00 – 7:30 pm, \$75, Taught by Coach David & Miss Stephanie. Limbering skills are the gateway to so many Tumbling skills, and it can be frustrating to be stuck on them. Help your tumbler get past them with this Workshop! 1 Point

Back Tucks and Beyond Intensive - Saturday 7/17, 10:00-11:30, \$40, Taught by Coach David. Does your tumbler have their back handspring? Let's get working on those back tucks! Do they already have their Back Tuck? Let's go beyond and work on roundoff back tuck, layouts, front tucks, maybe add a half or full twist! ½ Point

Back Handspring Intensive – Saturday 7/17, 12:30-2:00, \$40, Taught by Coach David. Is your tumbler working on their Back Handspring, but hasn't quite gotten there yet? This is the Intensive for them! ½ Point
